Clarence Lytle, President, and May Jeffries, Assistant Secretary, of THE LITTLE MIAMI EAST FORK RIVERS CITIZENS HISTORICAL SOCIETY, an Ohio corporation, organized not for profit, do hereby certify that (at a meeting of the members of said corporation duly called and held on the 13th day of April, 1973, at 8 o'clock P. M., at which meeting a quorum of such members were present, and that by the affirmative vote of 11 of the members present thereat), (in a writing signed by all the members who would be entitled to notice of a meeting of such other corporation not less than a majority as the articles or regulations permit), the following resolution of amendment was adopted:


